RULES FOR VETERANS' QUEEN

(please read completely)

1. No drugs or alcohol shall be used while you are campaigning for the queen.
2. You must be polite to the people, regardless if they buy a ticket or not.
3. You should have a good appearance.
4. Clothing and sashes identifying you as a veterans' queen candidate are **prohibited**. Name tags will be provided by the Juniata County veterans' Council.
5. All money and sold and unsold tickets are **your** responsibility.
6. All tickets must match the money that is turned in.
 - a. Example: 1 dollar for each ticket
7. Tickets
 - a. Money must match the number of tickets sold.
 - b. All sold and unsold tickets must be returned.
8. Tickets must be in packs of 100, and the packs wrapped with a rubber band when they are turned in.
 - a. Tickets sold must have the contestant's name on the back.

9. Do not put your name or a date on the tickets until they are sold.
10. The candidate and representative ***must*** be present at the final counting of the tickets.
11. Do not let vying for Veteran's Queen interfere with your school studies; they are more important.
12. The escort accompanying the candidate to the Queen's Ball must be appropriately attired. Appropriately attired is defined as a coat and tie, no clothing with holes or tears.
